Dear Mr. Young,

We thank you for the opportunity to submit our proposal. If accepted and maintained our Integrated Mosquito Management Program will significantly reduce and control the quantity of mosquitoes actively breeding, feeding and sheltering within the treatment area.

Our objective is to lower the health risk of persons acquiring mosquito borne illnesses within this property.

A regional increase in mosquito borne diseases

Prior to 2013 the Caribbean people had one major mosquito borne disease that threatened their health. That was and still is Dengue Fever, a serious and at times life threatening disease. Then in December 2013 in Oyster Pond in French St Martin two visitors to the island became ill with Chikungunya. These were the first reported cases in the region and from there within 6 months Chikungunya spread throughout the Caribbean, Central and South America causing hundreds of thousands of persons to be ill. Then in 2015 another mosquito disease has appeared in our region for the very first time, called Zika, Zika like Chikungunya and Dengue has now spread throughout the Caribbean and further afield.

In 3 years we have gone from 1 mosquito disease to 3, a trend that is most concerning and certainly mandates a call for all persons to do more to reduce and control mosquitoes on their property.

The fact is that Government control mosquito programs in the Caribbean are short funded and lack the resources to effectively manage and control mosquitoes.
